Application Process Summary

Application for registration is accomplished in 1 of 2 ways:

- Horses from SBHA registered parents and under 24 months – Application form A
- Horses from unregistered or unknown parentage and at least 3 years of age – Application form B.

APPLICATION FORM A

For use on foals or horses not yet 24 months of age and from at least 1 SBHA registered parent.

APPLICATION FORM B

SBHA is an open registry, so we welcome applications for horses from sources other than the SBHA. The registration application fee for members is \$40; non-members is \$75, which includes One year of membership and is non-refundable. SBHA offers a Ranch rate if three or more applications are submitted together. The fee for each additional horse is reduced \$25.

Horses with at least one parent registered in the SBHA are eligible for either the General or Permanent divisions. Horses with neither parent registered with the SBHA are eligible only for the Appendix division.

PROCESS:

Submit an application for each horse with the fee and photographs as designated. Each horse will be inspected and if qualified, admitted to the appropriate division. The application can be found at:

Photographs:

Quality photographs with the horse properly positioned are necessary for the Inspectors to accurately evaluate each horse. Additional documents explaining how to take these photos are available on the Registration page of our website. Digital photos are preferred.

Measurements:

Application B requires a number of measurements to be provided for each horse. A document describing how to measure is available on the REGISTRATION page of the SBHA website.

Inspections:

Each applicant will be inspected by three SBHA Official Inspectors in which the horse is evaluated for Spanish Barb traits based on our Breed Standard as well as quality of conformation. The Breed Standard is available on our website. Inspection is normally done via the photographs. If adequate photos are not provided, inspection can take place at the location of the horse, but the owner is responsible for travel expenses for 2 inspectors.
